School Year Wednesday Night Programming – dinner and activities for all ages! This September we look forward to restarting our Wednesday night community meals and small group/class gatherings. Given the popularity of dinner and great response for programming for all ages, we are working on getting ready for the following schedule from September through April:

### **LEARNING MORE ABOUT....**

Wednesday Night School Year Programming: Middle School Ministry (Grades 6-8) New groups start in the fall, winter, and spring. Each series includes approximately 6-8 weeks for middle school group time. The teaching times are facilitated by our pastor along with trained adult volunteers who assist with small group time and mentoring. The fall semester focuses on exploring the Bible. The winter group includes mentor involvement as students go deeper into questions about faith and life. The spring focuses on Christian living, service, and social time. Students interested in being confirmed attend the Middle School classes as part of their confirmation requirements, but students do not have to seek confirmation to participate.

# Wednesday Night School Year Programming: Senior High Ministry

New groups start in the fall, winter, and spring, each lasting about 6-8 sessions. Each series includes approximately 6-8 weeks for small group time. Groups are facilitated by trained adult volunteers and focus on creating a space for students to find support and encouragement for their lives of faith and develop leadership skills and service opportunities.
