“We Have Instruments Built Into Us To Worship” Part I

1. Priesthood, let us establish a definition for the word “Worship”. When we use the word “Worship” we are talking about a practice (defined: to cause one to perform an act or series of acts repeatedly in order to master or strengthen a skill or ability. To follow, pursue, repeat) that goes beyond ritual. (Sunday Morning Service). **We are really describing man’s walk and relationship with a Holy and a Righteous God.** A relationship that Respects and Honors God’s Holiness, His Majesty, and His Worth. They adore, obey, reverence and focus positive attention on God only. (Exodus 34:14; John 4:23). To enjoy the Presence of God. Any action or attitude that expresses praise, shows love and appreciation for Our True and Living God. Worship can be expressed through obedience (Micah 6:8) and the way we treat people (Matt 25:37-40). Worship can be private or public (Matt 6:6; Hebrew 10:24-25).
2. Isaiah 14 and Ezra 28 explains the rise and fall of satan. Why did satan fall? Root cause answer: Worship. Isaiah 14:12
3. The five “I’s” that caused him to fall from Heaven, Isaiah 14:12-15. (Note: the words that have to do with being lifted up over God, i.e. ascend, exalts, up, up, over, etc...) (Satan was always in Heaven; however, he wanted to be higher/above God. Note: Mount was where the Congregation in Heaven gather regularly to Worship God).
4. God’s response – This is to all who seek to be like God in the wrong way for the wrong reason. Matt 25:41; Rev 14:9; 20:10-15; 21:8; 22:15. Satan wanted worship so bad he begged Jesus for it. Matt: 4:8-11. Note: Fall Down. Worship must be expressed through action and Passion. Worship is Love.
5. They loved His teaching with Authority, His Miracles, His Healings, however, Jesus always Glorified Father (John 12: 42-43,49-50). The more you become like Jesus, the more you will give God and others the Glory, spending less time speaking of yourself. Example: John the Baptist, “He must increase, but I must decrease”.
6. Satan started out wanting to be Worshipped. He copies God in every way he can. In the beginning of the Bible to the end satan wants to be Worshipped. Rev 13:4; 12:9. (Who is like unto Jehovah) the Dragon. Verse 11, Satan was created with instruments, however, when he fell his pomp (sound of his strings were brought down). Ezra 28:11-16.
 - Satan was perfect in beauty; in the garden; King of Tyrus came approx. 3400 years after the fall.
 - V14 Anointed Cherub “Angels” three Arch Angels, Michael (Prayer) Gabriel (Word) Lucifer (Worship Leader). Pillars on which the Church is built. When we come together, we Pray, Worship, and Word of God.

Merchandising; Lucifer walking up and down slandering God to His own servants, rebelling and taking angels under his power. Stealing God’s Worship. God

immediately kicked him out.

7. Satan's instruments were built within him. Our musical instruments are built within us, when we sing, shout, Praise, Worship, etc... we are using our instruments.
8. Ez 28:13 God's Workmanship built within us to Worship (inside our physical bodies):
 - Tabrets – in English, means Tambourine –percussion –cymbals, feet, hands, etc.
 - Pipes – Wind instruments in our throats, something you blow assisted by wind, i.e. clarinet, trumpet, flute.
 - String – Vocal cords
9. 1 Chron 13:8 - Miracles happen in the Spiritual realm when we Worship.
10. 2 Ch 5:11-14 – As One “Word of Faith Saints of the Most High” using their instruments.
11. Gen 1:1-2. Satan kicked out because of rebellion – the earth was void and empty- Chaos (Greek) – without form.
12. Then God got busy – Bringing Light – Glory - Light, Day and Night, Sea, Land, Flowers, Birds, etc.... Gen 1:3.
13. There was only one thing missing – (Worship). Then God made Man (Us) and restored the void and darkness with the “Light of the World” JESUS CHRIST, Gen 1:27.

Worship Belongs to God (Part II)

1. Worship:
 - Worship Belongs to God Only
 - Worship Comes Through Revelation (Revelation is a profound disclosure of divine truth, purpose, or knowledge, often experienced as a sudden “aha moment”, deep insight or feeling, unveiling what was previously hidden from an individual or humanity, and helping to form a clearer relationship with God)
 - Worship in the Spirit
 - Worship in Truth
 - Worship God
 - Worship the Ways of God
2. What is the meaning of Worship???? In the Hebrew, the word means to kneel and worship. In Greek, it means to go forward and kiss His Hand. In other words, to give Him everything.
3. What is Worship??? Understanding His Name is Hallow or Holy. Matt 6:9, set apart. Only He can be called Jehovah God. What is Worship?? It is simply this, I recognize that He is God and that I am only human. When I see God as Father, I am Saved; When I see God as God, I am finished and done with. For when I see Him as God, we can only fall down humbly and Worship Him. The entire matter rests upon our seeing.
4. What is Worship??? Confessing Him as God only.
5. Ex 20:3-8, 34:14; Deut 4:15-19, 30:17-19; 1 Kings 9:6-7,9; 2 Chron. 29:28-30; Neh 9:3,6;Ps 95:6; 99:5; 132:7; Matt 2:2,11; Matt 4:9-10; John 4:23; Rev 4:10-11, 5:14; 22:8-9
6. Praise is initiated by us. Worship is God’s response.
7. Praise is something we do. Worship is something God releases.
8. Praise is our building a House for God. Worship is God moving in.
9. Worship cannot be generated by us, it is completely dependent on God.
10. Only by Revelations will we know God; by surrender we know His Ways. To Worship God is to Worship His Ways.
11. What is one way I can Worship His Ways? Pray: Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done, as it is in Heaven. (Matt 6:10.) That means there will be no human will coming out to limit Him.
12. Two things are needed for Revelation: (1) Light from God (2) Opened eyes.
13. Why is it sometimes difficult for man to Worship God.
 - There must be Death before Worship- No Power or Energy from humans.
 - Some believers have changed their subject to Salvation, but not their source of power and energy.
 - God has done everything regarding Salvation and service. He has done all the Works, that is to rule out everything that is of man so, He can get all of His Glory.

- Man must let God break that natural energy, just as God touched the socket of Jacob's hip. Gen 32:24-25, Jacob continued to walk but, He also continued to limp. Every true servant of God knows the touch of that wound, from which he can never recover.

14. Death, in principle, has to be worked out in crisis to our natural life. It is by passing through the trials of life, then God releases us into His Resurrection, then we can Worship.
15. The devil wants God's Worship, Is 14:12-14, Matt 4:1-11. The first two temptations had no real advantage for satan, but the third, his deepest desire, "Worship me," he says.
16. A particular line of Worship runs through Revelations from chapter 4 and 5 to chapter 19, we learn that twenty four Elders and the four creatures worshipped in Heaven. But in chapter 13, we see worship of the image, of the beast on earth.
17. Since God's purpose is Worship and Satan's purpose is worship, what is the duty of the Saints?????? The answer: to Worship God only, in Spirit and in Truth.
18. What is it that will satisfy God??? Not those who can just pray or preach, but, those who will Love, Adore and Worship Him.
19. The Lord Jesus came into this world to restore Worship to God. Satan tries to rob God of His Worship, and man is tempted to Worship any and everything other than God, Himself.
20. Why does Satan fear the Salvation of Men?? Because they will then be able to Worship God. That is why he hates for men to be Saved, he loses Worship.
21. Praise is Seeking God. Worship is being found by Him.
22. A true Worshipper loves to be with God and God loves being with Him. John 4:21-24.
23. Why does God choose the foolish, the weak, and the abase things of the world to confound the wise; (1 Cor 1:27-28). Because their souls are not puffed up. When we live after the Spirit, God gets what He wants, Worship. If, however, we live after the soul (puffed up) satan gets what he wants.
24. **WHAT THE ENTIRE WORLD WILL GIVE GOD ONE DAY, WE WILL GIVE HIM FIRST-NOW!!!! WE WILL NOT WAIT UNTIL THE NEW HEAVEN OR THE NEW EARTH. WE WILL WORSHIP-NOW.**
25. **IF WE ARE DEFEATED IN PRAISE AND WORSHIP, WE WILL BE DEFEATED IN OTHER THINGS.**

“Types of Prayer”

1. What Prayer is and what Prayer is not? Prayer is the union of the Believer’s thought with the Will of God, period. It is simply a Believer speaking out of His mouth, the Will of God, Matt 6:10 – Thy Kingdom Come, They Will Be Done. It is not an expression of our wishes for God to yield to our petitions and fill up our selfish desires.
2. A Believer’s life should be based and built upon the Word of God.
3. The Bible instructs us to always pray in Eph 6:18. There are several kinds of Prayer in addition to the ones we are discussing below. The Prayer to be prayed should be depending on what God needs/wants (desires), we need to understand the importance of each.
4. Prayer produces Power with God. It brings brokenness in us and favor with God. It has to do with the whole person (1 Thess 5:23). When a person prays, he does it with his whole nature. A person’s body actively engages in prayer. For example, the kneeling down in prayer can be assumed as the kneel of one’s soul, i.e. emotions, etc...
5. The Prayer of Faith – Matt 21:21,22; Mark 11:24. The Prayer of Faith applies primarily to a person’s own life-to his own situation and circumstances. It applies to your desires, your prayers. Not someone else’s prayer concerning you. Usually in conjunction with the prayer of petition. To boldly speak a command of Faith or against a situation ALOUD.
6. Let’s use games as an example in how to use different types of Prayers. Football rules cannot be used in basketball. The Prayer of Faith cannot be used as a Prayer of Agreement. If you try to use wrong prayers for situations, that are not to be used, you get no results. There are principles and spiritual laws that govern Prayer as in any situation. Example: Jesus prayed in the Garden, “If It Be Thy Will”. When He rose us Lazarus, He did not say, “If It Be Thy Will”. Luke 22:42. He said, “Lazarus come forth”.
7. The Prayer of Intercession – The Word “intercede” means to act between two parties, with the thought of reconciling the two of them. Standing in the gap, in Prayer on behalf of another. Is 64:7, this implies if someone would have stirred themselves and interceded judgement would not have come; Gen 18:23-32; Mal 3:5,6. Praying for another private, from a distance, or face to face. Ezekiel 22:30; Romans 8:26,27;1 Cor 14:14. The Holy Spirit will help us intercede, these groanings are from God, coming out of our spirit: 1 Tim 2:1-6; James 5:13-18. This prayer sometimes requires praying repeatedly for a person, a situation or a group of people. You come between God and another. Apostle Paul in Ephesians chapters 1, 3 and Col chapter 1. This prayer might include tongues, groaning and/or laboring.
8. Anytime you are praying to change something or get something according to His Word, never pray “If it be Thy Will”. Use “If” in a Prayer of Consecration or Dedication.

9. Praying in Tongues – A sure thing. Using your Heavenly language to speak with God, at any time, and you will always be in His perfect Will. Romans 8:26-27. Isaiah 28:11-12; 33:19.
10. The Prayer of Praise – When we extol God’s Virtues, His Character, His Love, His Mercy, etc.....and boldly compliment Him, boast on Him and talk about Him ALOUD!!!! Hebrews 13:15. We enter into His Presence with Praise. Psalm 100:4. Praise silences the devil and paralyzes his activity against your life. Psalm 8:2; Matt 21 :16.
11. The Prayer of Worship – Focusing on Who God is. Acts 13:2-3 (See Worship Tab B)
12. Closet Prayers – Matt 6:5, the Lord tells His disciples to pray privately, there is nothing wrong with public prayer. Private prayer is personal time with God.
13. United Prayer – When a group of Believers, lift up their voices together aloud towards a common end but using their own individuals. prayers. POWERFUL PRAYERS. Acts 4:24
14. Prayer of Supplications – A more fervent and desperate form of petition. When the ordinary petition just does not give you a release or results you need or want. This prayer is a more powerful and emotional form of petition, that is more forceful. Hebrews 5:7; Dan 10:12-13.
15. Prayer of Repentance – To feel a deep sense of hurt or pain for wrongdoing. Luke 11:4; Mk 1:15; Mk 6:12; Luke 13:1-5; Acts 2:38.
16. The Prayer of Thanksgiving – What God has done and is doing. When you recount the things God has done and is going to do. We have received and received and received, sight, smell, legs, jobs food, children, safety, etc..... And by faith what you are expecting Him to do. Thank Him for being God, My Father, Savior, Redeemer, etc....
17. The Prayer of Consecration and Dedication– When you are sincerely seeking God’s Will over a decision. Luke 22:42; Romans 12:1-2. Pray this prayer when you are placing your will in neutral and earnestly seeking God’s preference concerning spiritual matters, marriage, business, etc.....
18. The Prayer of Forgiveness – When you have been hurt or offended by others. Mark 11:25-26; Matt 6:14; 18:35.
19. The Prayer of Authority - (Binding or Loosing) – A Commanding Prayer. When you need to get the devil off your back or assisting in someone else’s situation. Matt 18:18; Mark 16:17. Heaven will always agree with earth when you bind.
20. Prayer of Agreement/Binding and Loosing – When you need another believer to help you to get through to God or when you offer to help another receive an answer from God. Matt 18:18-20. This prayer is usually prayed aloud with two or three, sometimes holding hands. NOTE: If one can put a thousand to flight; two can put ten thousand to flight. Lev 26:8; Deut 32:30
21. Spiritual Warfare Prayers – Warring against the principalities and powers of darkness. Ep 6:12.

The KINGDOM Mind

1. The Greek word for “Kingdom” is basileia, meaning “Realm” or a “Region” governed by a “King”. There is no Kingdom without a King. Our King is “Jesus”.
2. A Kingdom is the governing influence of a King over His territory, impacting it with His personal Mind/Will (God’s Will), God’s Mind, His purpose, His intent, which produces His Culture, His Values, His Morals and His Lifestyle that reflect the King’s (Jesus) desires and nature for His citizens.
3. Gen 1:26 Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the...”
4. THE FIRST thing God did was give man a Kingdom. This statement documents the most important declaration ever regarded to mankind. This is clear, that the MIND, motivation, nature, purpose, and mandate behind man’s creation are for man to dominate the earth, as he remains in the Mind of God. Dominion here translates to the Hebrew word “Manlakah”, which translates to “Kingdom”, “Sovereign Rule” or “Royal Power”.
5. Image in the Hebrew means a shadow, which is the outline or shadowing of the original. Likeness, similarity, resemblance, consist of the moral qualities of God!! The likeness consists of the moral qualities of God, whereas the image involves the natural attributes of God. When Adam fell, he lost likeness, but the image remained fully intact!!
6. How can we see the Kingdom of God??? John 3:5, Only by New Birth!!!
7. We are judged by how realistically we capture the person or thing we are to portray!! Let the Mind of Christ be also in you, Phil 2:5, the mind of self-emptying. Made Himself of no reputation, and took on the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of man. Phil 2:5-7.
8. Elohiym, the Powerful one filled the man with a representation of Himself. That is why Romans 12:1-3 are essential!! “Mind renewal”.
9. Being Kingdom minded is God’s way for all of life to be lived. It is something that needs to remain at the forefront of our thinking, to fully penetrate our choices and decisions, bringing them fully into the Will and Mind of God Phil 2:5!!
10. To be Kingdom minded is lacking today. That is because people do not speak of the Kingdom, and that is because much of their speech deals with their mind, their feelings, their issues and situations, which do not include Kingdom thinking!! Matt 6:9-15,33.
11. The absence of Kingdom-mindedness has led to a deterioration of God’s Presence in our Church and in the world. Some of God’s people lack Kingdom minded views, because they exist for their own fulfillment rather than for God’s Kingdom.
12. Pastors and Churches are having a limited impact on society, because they fail to understand the Mind of God and the goal of the Church. It is not we ourselves, but the Kingdom. This very fact, itself keeps the Church divided and not producing Christ-minded Disciples.
13. God will raise up people with His own mind 1 Sam 2:35, “I will raise me up a faithful Priest, that shall do according to that which is in Mine Heart and in My Mind.”

14. What happened to Man's "Kingdom"? He lost it Gen 3:23. We should never rethink God's Word!! Matt 22:37; Rom 8:27; Romans 12:1,2.

15. In man's mind, he had to have a "Kingdom". That is why he created "Religion" because he lost fellowship with God, the Only True King, so man made himself a king.

- A religious mind is what man does until he becomes Kingdom-minded.
- A religious mind prepares man to leave earth; the Kingdom-mindedness empowers man to dominate earth!! Gen 1:26-28.
- A religious mind focuses on Heaven; the Kingdom minded focuses on (Thy Kingdom come on earth as it is in Heaven, thy Will be done on earth.)
- A religious mind is reaching up to God; the Kingdom of God has come down to man and lives in him, (Holy Spirit, Love, Joy, Peace, Mercy, Healing etc...)
- A religious mind wants to escape earth, the Kingdom mind impacts, influences and changes earth. (Healing, Deliverance, etc.....)
- A religious mind seeks to take earth to Heaven; the Kingdom mind seeks to bring Heaven to earth. JESUS, etc.....

16. In 2 Tim 1:7 - "God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and love and of a sound mind. "Sound" In the Greek means discipline, sober, living in God's Divine balance, chaste, self-controlled, regulating self-behavior. Divinely balancing your life. No middle ground!!!

17. A Kingdom mind longs for the Word of God!!!!

18. A Kingdom mind is humble, Acts 20:19!!

19. A Kingdom mind will keep you in Perfect Peace (whose mind). It is Isaiah 26:3.

20. A Kingdom mind is a willing mind. 2 Cor 8:12.

21. A Kingdom mind and heart 1 Chron 29:9.

22. Kingdom minded people agree with God in every area of their lives Amos 3:3!!!

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“The Kingdom” Part II

1. A Kingdom is “The Governing influence of a King over His territory, impacting it with His Personal Will, Purpose, and Intent, producing a culture, values, morals and lifestyle that reflect the King.
2. Kingdom in the Greek translates to basileia meaning “a realm”, which can be translated as “Sovereign Rule or Royal Power” and in the Hebrew it means “Dominion”, take over, rule.
3. In the last few centuries, some countries, once known kingdoms have become republics, for reason that they no longer have a King, instead are governed by the people. There is no Kingdom without a King, instead are governed by the people.
4. God gave man power, he lost it. Gen 1:26. Jesus came to restore Power to His Kingdom. 1 Cor 15:24.
5. Jesus’ first public statement, Matt 4:17; in other Words if you repent, it is in you.
6. Religion vs. Kingdom - Religion will keep you out of the Kingdom. Matt 23:13, 15; Matt 5:20; 21:28-34.
7. What is the priority of God? Matt 6:25-34.
8. When man rejects God’s Government, he became his own government (i.e., Dictatorship, Communism, Socialisms, Democracy).
9. We are God’s responsibility “Welfare”. It is a word used to express a King’s commitment to His citizens.
10. God has designed the “Colonization Concept”, the original purpose was to establish a manifestation of His Heavenly Kingdom on earth without the necessity of His physical Presence. A King does not have to be present to do this. Matt 18:18-20.
11. Define Kingdom of God and Kingdom of Heaven. Matt 3:2; 5:3, 10, 19-20; 7:21; 8:11 etc... The Kingdom of Heaven is spoken about mainly in Matthew. It presents Jesus as Jehovah King; Mark’s Gospel presents Christ as Jehovah Servant; Luke presents Him as Jehovah Man and John presents Him as the Anointed One or the Divine One-God manifested in the flesh.
12. The word “Heaven” in all of the above passages means “the Kingdom from Heaven”. It refers to Jesus’ Kingdom on earth. It was the first subject of His Ministry Matt 3:2; 4:17.
13. The Main subjects of the Gospels are:
 - First, the Proclamation of the Kingdom. (304 verses) Matt 4:12-7:29; Mark 1:14-20; Luke 4:14-5:11; Jn 1:35-4:54 etc.....
 - Second, the Proclamation of the King. (964 verses) Mt. 8:1-16:20; Mk. 1:21-8:30; Luke 5:12-9:21; Jn 5:1-6:71 etc.....
 - Third, the Rejection of the King. (901 verses) Mt 16:21-20:34; Mk 8:31-10:52; Lk 9:22-18:43; Jn 7:1-11:53 etc.....
 - Fourth, the Rejection of the Kingdom (782 verses, Mt. 21:1-26:35; Mk 11:1-14:25; Luke 19:1-22:38; Jn 11:54-17:26 etc.....

- Men are never told to seek the Kingdom of Heaven.

14. The Kingdom of Heaven is the literal reign of Heaven over the Earth. It is the sphere of - the profession of the Christian. Establishing holiness in the earth, on jobs, in our homes, families, etc...

15. It involves citizens of one country, inhabiting foreign territory, for the purpose of influencing that domain with the culture and values of their native country and governing it with the laws of that homeland.

16. The Kingdom of God Matt 6:33; 12:28; 19:24; 21:31,43; Mark 1:14-15; 4:11,22,30; 9:147; 10:14-15,23-25; etc... means the absolute Sovereignty of God over the universe and includes and embraces the “Kingdom of Heaven and all realms in the whole universe. It is universal and has been from the beginning and will see no end. The Kingdom of God existed before the creation of the earth.

17. “My Kingdom is not of this world...” John 18:33b, 36-38.

18. THE FIRST THING WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND IS A KING IS THE CENTRAL COMPONENT OF HIS KINGDOM. WITHOUT THE KING, THERE IS NOT KINGDOM.

19. THE KINGDOM BELONGS TO THE KING. THE KING IS THE ULTIMATE SOURCE OF AUTHORITY. IF HE HAS NOT DESIGNATED IT, IT IS NOT AUTHORITY.

20. IF WE ARE NOT OBEDIENT, WE ARE NOT POSITIONED PROPERLY IN THE KINGDOM.

21. A KING WILL CHOOSE WHO WILL BE A CITIZEN of His Kingdom.

22. Haggai 2:8; Use of anything is a privilege; We have no right to ourselves. We belong to Jesus. Ps 24:7-10

23. In the Kingdom of God, there are no subjects; only citizens—but, every citizen is a King (or Queen) in his or her right.

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Hell – Appointment for the Wicked

1. Hell defined – Hebrew, sheol, the unseen world, the place of departed spirits, not the grave. God is the one who made hell for the devil and his angels, and all men who follow satan. God is the one who sends to hell and confines rebels there for eternity. Hell. (Matt 16:18; Luke 16:19-31), These are the torment compartments of sheol-hades where wicked souls have always gone and will always go until the end of the Millennium. The wicked will be brought out to be reunited with their resurrected and immortal bodies and to be cast into the lake of fire for eternity Rev 20:11-15. Place of extreme eternal punishment. Located in the lower part of the earth. Ps 63:9.
2. Luke 16:19-31 – Story of two Beggars, one begged before, one after Luke:16:19-31 He was in sheol with his spiritual body parts. The inner man is as real as the physical man, having spiritual parts that fit into the physical. The rich man in hell had eyes, and other bodily parts, as well as full consciousness, while out of his body.

Facts about Hell:

- A place of wrath (Deut. 32:22)
- A place of sorrow (Ps 18:5; 116:3)
- A deep place (Job 11:8; Amos 9:2; Ps 139:8)
- Men go into it in a moment (Job 21:13; Ps 55:15; Luke 16:19-31)
- A place naked before God; not man. (Job 26:6; Proverb 15:11)
- A place for the wicked only (Ps 9:17; Job 24:19; Proverbs 5:5).
- A place for souls (Rev 20:13; Pr 86:13 23:14; Ps 116:3; Pr 5:5; Is 5:14; Hab 2:5; Matt 5:29-30)
- A place where men are conscious of God (Ps139:8; Isa 14:9-20)
- A place where souls are alive (Num 16:30,33; Ps 55:15)
- A place that is never full or satisfied (Pro 27:20; 30:16; Hab 2:5)
- A place of gates and bars (Jobs 17:16; Isa 38:10; Matt 16:18 Rev 1:18)
- Has enlarged herself (Is 5:8-17)
- Jesus said it was prepared for the devil and his angels (Matt 25:41)
- Revelations says that men will be tormented day and night forever.
- Is located in the “lower part of the earth” (Ps 63:9;Eph 4:7-11);the heart of the earth, (Matt 12:40) the other part of the earth, (Ezek 31:14-18; 32:18-27), and beneath the earth like a pit (Pro 15:24; Is 14:9-15; Ez 31:14-18).

3. Who is going to hell?

- Those who are not in the Book of Life. Rev 20:11-15
- Refusing the Gospel (2 Thess 1:7-9) What is the Gospel?? It is not Jesus answering our prayers; it is not Jesus Christ, healing or providing. The Gospel is Jesus died for your sins on the Cross, as a sacrifice for us. And He died and rose again. (1 Cor 15:3-4). He committed no sin, we did. That is the Gospel.
- The Fear of Man Pro 29:25; Rev 21:8
- Persecuting Christians, Matt 23:29-35
- Trampling the Precious Blood of Jesus!! Heb 9:22;1 Pet 1:18;19;1John 1:7
- All who maketh a lie (FAKING, GAS LIGHTING), unbelieving, fearful, murderers, sorcerers, idolaters, whoremonger and LIARS, etc.....; Rev 21:8.

4. Warn the wicked Ezekial 3:17-21. Tell people about God.
5. There have been many testimonies of people going to hell and returning. Some describe it as darker than dark, screams filling the air; long tunnels; piercing cries; the worst odor they have ever smelled; burning flesh; huge snakes crawling everywhere; giant worms; horrid place of torment; excruciating pain; no love; no compassion; evil creatures flying around; brimstone; red hot coals of fire; people cursing as they burn; millions of souls are already there; flames of fire all around; chains after chains, etc...
6. Matt 13:37-42; 49-50; 25:41-46.
7. Lost souls grieve God Ez 33:11; Peter 3:9.
8. What is God saying to us concerning our souls Ez 33:10-20; 1Peter 4:17-19.
9. All seeing Judge Pr 15:3
10. God will Judge us according to our ways Ezekiel 7:4

11. Some facts concerning the Wicked:

- The triumph of the wicked is short Job 20:5
- The wicked borroweth, payeth not back, Ps 37:21
- He will deal unjustly with his neighbor – Pro 3:28; 4:25; Lev 24:19
- He will refuse to recognize God in all His tender Mercies. Micah 6:8
- Bad treatment of the Man or Woman of God. 1 Chr 16:22; Ps 105:15.

12. NOTE TO THE PRAYER WARRIORS OF WOFC; Is 65:18-25 proves that Prayer will continue in the Millennium and the new earth period. vs. 24.

13. There are five departments mentioned in the Word of God describing the underworld of departed spirits.

- Tartarus. (1 Pet 3:19;2 Peter, 2:4-6; Jude 6-7). Special prison for fallen angels, who sinned before the flood.
- Paradise. (Luke 16:19-31; 23:43) This was the abode of the righteous after physical death where they were held captive by the devil against their will, until Jesus conquered death, hell and the grave. It is now empty of the righteous, who go to Heaven at death, since Jesus captured the captive and took them to Heaven with Him.
- Hell. (Matt 16:18; Luke 16:19-31), This is the torment compartments of sheol-hades where wicked souls have always gone and will always go until the end of the Millennium. The wicked will be brought out to be reunited with their resurrected and immortal bodies and to be cast into the lake of fire for eternity. Rev 20:11-15 Place of extreme eternal punishment. Located in the lower part of the earth. Ps 63:9.

- The Abyss or bottomless pit. (Luke 8:26-31; Romans 10:7; Rev 9:1-3; 11:7; 17:8; 20:1-10) This is the abode of demons and some angelic beings. No human soul or spirit ever go here. The OT equivalent is Abaddon and is translated destruction. Job 26:5-6; 28:22; 31:12; Ps 88:11; 27:20.
- Lake of Fires. This is the eternal hell and perdition of all fallen angels, demons and wicked men. (Rev 20:6 11-15; 21:8; 22:15). It is the final hell prepared for the devil and his angels. (Matt 25:41) and is eternal in duration, Matt 25:46; Rev 14:9-14; 19:20-21:10-15; Isa; 66:22-24.

Unforgiveness Will Kill You

1. Read Gensis Chapters 30-50.
2. Unforgiveness is the one area in that can absolutely hinder the blessings of God in your life and has been known to cause sickness and death.
3. It is a big deal in the Bible and in our lives. It is critical.
4. Nothing will hurt you as bad, it will cause disfellowship with the Father and bitterness.
5. If the person that has hurt you, has not asked for forgiveness, you must forgive them anyway. Matt 6:12, 15; Mark 11:25-26
6. If anyone had a right to hold a grudge it was Joseph. Gen 37:18-28
7. Everyone will deal with this issue in life, from family and friends.
8. The life of Joseph was so important to God that he was spoke of from Chapters 37-50.
9. God had to do it; Jesus had to deal with it and so do we.
10. Gen 50:15-17, Joseph had to face the issue and still forgive.
11. Forgiveness – a decision not to hold an offense against an offender. It is a choice. A decision. Not an emotional moment. It is not how you feel. It's really a life decision.
12. How do you know you have forgiven a person? You seek no revenge against the offender/payback. “You are the vengeance is mine”, kind of person. You let God handle it. You keep no record. 1 Cor 13:5.
13. Forgiveness can operate on two levels:
 - Unilateral – You forgive the person, (they have not asked or repented of the offense); on your own.
 - Why would you? For several reasons: 1. Maybe it was a small offense. 2. They died so they cannot say I'm sorry. 3. They disappeared- they cannot ask for forgiveness.
 - However, you forgive them so that you can move on. Ex. Steven Act 7:60; Jesus on the Cross, “Forgive them, for they not what they do.” Unforgiveness is a hostage.
 - Transactional – Desire for restoring/reconciliation, to fix something that has been broken. This particular person is willing to confess and restore. However, confession (just saying it) and repentance (action) are totally different.
14. The brothers wanted to be forgiven and said they were sorry; however, Joseph did not believe it. That is why he made them prove it Gen 42:14-16. Youngest brother v.16 They had 43 another test/cup in Benjamin's bag. Would they protect Benjamin or trade him? Bible, say we need to seed/plant fruits of repentance. Amen
15. Some people say I'm sorry because that is the thing to do. But saying you are sorry is just words. When a person says they are sorry and continue with the same behavior, they are saying they have not repented of the behavior and there is no fruit of repentance, as John the Baptist states in the book of Matt 3:8; Luke 3:8; Acts 26:20; 2 Cor 7:10.

16. Repentance (Change of action) opens the door to restoring a relationship.

17. Some restorations are limited. Example relationships.

18. But the Bible says as much as possible. Heb 12:14. Walk in Peace!

19. Steps to validate your forgiveness. Gen 45:1 show JOSEPH as a man of God as he did not expose his family. Gen 44:18-45.

- You don't involve anyone who does not have anything to do with unforgiveness. They are not involved. He dismissed all his servants.
- You know you have forgiven when you make the offender feel at ease with you. Then Joseph said, "Please come closer to me". When you have not forgiven you say do not come close to me.
- Help the offender to forgive themselves. He said, "Don't be angry with yourselves". They were upset with themselves. He helps them to forgive themselves.
- How can we do that??? V5. You sold me but, God sent me here. God uses the mess to promote you. You must see God in the situation.
- V9, Say to Father "I am ok" not what you did to me, how you treated me. He protected the one that would be hurt the most, the Father.
- If you are holding on to vengeance, then you are blocking God from caring for you. God will let you pay back. "Vengeance is mine, said the Lord and I will repay," His way, His time.
- Joseph did not ignore it. Because he said, "you all sold me here".

20. What helped Joseph forget? Ch 41:50-52. Two sons were born. First born "Manasseh", He has made me forget all my toil and all my father's house. And the name of the second was name "Ephraim", for God has caused me to be fruitful in my land of affliction. God gave him a new family.

21. That showed that he was delivered. We need a Manasseh, an ongoing example something to remind us of God deliverance and a God is Blessing me right now. Care, blessings, health, and strength.

22. God is Blessing me in presence of my enemy. Ps 23. Joseph wasn't supposed to be there.

23. God will show up and show out. Call it out every day (Pray for the person you are battling forgiving) and that will deliver you. You will be fruitful in the place where you are.

24. What happens when you forgive??? It crosses you over to the supernatural.

25. Matt 6 "Forgive us, as we forgive others". We need to be forgiven also. We all need both. And when you do, Father will give you Peace, Authority, Deliverance, Joy, Blessings.

Four Ways to Know God is with You in Your Trial

God has a destiny for each of us and has had it before the foundation of the world. However, before we reach this destination, God takes us through many detours. It is rare that a person is saved and goes directly to Heaven. In life there are many signals, detours, yellow, green and red lights, yield signs, etc... Our responsibility is to ask for wisdom, to know which is which. It is important to understand the Voice of God to go on green, not to go on red, and to go around on detours, etc..

1. When we see a detour on the street, we know men are constructing something. God takes us on a detour in life, because He is trying to construct something in us.
2. Detours are inconvenient and take us out of our way, usually takes the trip longer than it was planned. Using patience not allotted for this unexpected detour, (lol). That is how we sometimes feel about the deliverance we are seeking. Why is this extra???? Because God is more concerned about our character than our comfort; and our development, than our arrival.
3. Shall we use Joseph as a template for this study. Joseph had a dream at 17 (Genesis Chapter 37), hurt/left to die by his family, the pit/jail, he was a slave, all of which was a huge detour, after which, he became second in Command Ruler of all Egypt. And was given power by God to deliver the very same people that caused his trial (His Family).
4. How do we know if we are on a detour, is it God's or mine?? How do we know if we are in the Will of God? If I am not on a detour; am I in the Will of God or out of the Will? How do I know it is God or Circumstances?
5. How do I know?
 - You are being persecuted for Righteous Sake. Genesis 37:18-25. His Family was Jealousy. He did nothing to go through that horror (maybe young a man's pride, bragging).
 - Gen 39:7,10,12 People Lying. Why was he in jail??? He was suffering for doing right. Joseph ran; she lied. He was being accused of a rape he did not commit. He was suffering for righteousness sake. He was obeying God, by not committing adultery.
 - When we are persecuted, experience suffering and struggles for doing God's Will, we are in the center of God's Will, exactly where He wants us to be.
6. Persecuted means to be treated in an evil manner. To be persecuted in Righteous means to be treated wrong because you chose to obey God. When Joseph said no, there was negative repercussions because He chose to bring Glory to God.
7. In this perverted evil world, if we make the choice to please, walk with, honor and obey God, satan will know and attack you in any way he can. 2 Tim 3:10-12!!!!
8. If you never get persecuted, you are not a Christian or you are not a very good one. The Bible says all of us that have made up our mind to love and serve Him will be Blessed.

“..... In the world, you will have tribulation but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.” Jn 16:33; 2 Cor 8:2

9. Sometimes we will have to make choices, everyone will not be your friend. You will have to make choices that will go against the grain, because you are marching to a different drum. You are not listening to the beat of this world.
10. Relationship – Got to make a choice – Friends- Marriage – Church-Jobs. etc...
11. Daniel 6:3, 4,5,10,13 You must not assimilate. You must STAND for God.
12. Compromise. People will have no respect for you, if you are a jelly fish.
13. The most critical test to endure is when you suffer for something and you have done nothing. When you have done all that God has said, nothing changes, you hurt, you cry. Just Stand. God has already worked it out. Eph 6:13-14; 2 Thess 2:15
14. 1 Peter 2:17-20. Being punished for unrighteous sake is not the same as being punished for righteous sake. The Bible says, “The Way of a Transgressor is Hard.”
15. You can be assured God is always with us in trial for righteous sake. Gen 39:19-23. Joseph was in jail, but God was there with him. Gen Ch 40:1-4.
16. Joseph life was not so easy, but God was there. He was right in God’s Will but still being persecuted. Heb 13:5.
17. When we mirror Jesus, when we act as mirrors to the world, they try to crush us.
18. In The Trial:
 - #1 The world will never see itself unless we become the mirror. We must mirror Jesus Christ, and the world will not like it, and will try to take us out. They are not our friends. They will turn on us in a split second. Remember Jesus said, “If the world hates you, it hated me before it hated you, if you were of the world, the world would love you.” John 15:18
 - #2 In the trial God shows Himself two or three times. He does not necessarily take you out of the trial but joins you in it. He must let you remain there 4 a while 4 His Glory. Dan 3:24-25; Act 7:9.
 - #3 It does not ever matter what trial you face, but it matters who is in the trial with you. God will show up, comfort you and let you know it is not time for deliverance, but for Him to be Glorified, to show Himself Strong and work in us and show us and the world that He is with us. Gen 39:1-6. The jailer knew Joseph was a good man.
 - #4 Gideon - Judge 6:37-40.
 - #5 Learn to Minister to others while in your trial. When Pharoah put the Baker and the Cup bear in the prison, he was worth. The two had one thing in common: food. Maybe there was a conspiracy to poison him. Maybe he had to put them in prison to search out the matter. He was getting ready to have his Birthday Party and he needed a cupbearer and a butler. Ch 40:20-22. That opened the to Joseph’s to freedom.
 - We never know what is connected to our deliverance. Note: Two criminals were connected to Joseph’s deliverances. We never know how or who God will use in our deliverance. God has placed many people in our lives to guide, assist, bless and help us if we allow them. Hebrew 13:1.
 - We must keep a servant heart in our trials. Gen 40:6-8. Joseph turned back to help. God used his Gift (dream to help the cup bear and the baker.) God will use what he has given you to Minister in your trial. Keep your Joy.

19. In all you do for God and helping people, most of the time, they are not going to be there when you need them. They forget where they came from. Betray you. Forget all you've done for them. Just remember that you love them and you are God's outstretched Arm to them. You will see it all again on Judgment Day. Gen 40:14-15, 23. But so many just forget all you do. You know you are in God's Will, when you just keep on loving.
20. When God postpone our deliverance. Dan 3:16-28. He is doing a powerful Work for us and in us. Stand fast. Do not compromise or sin, serve other gods, or quit.
