# Read Mark 1:2 and Malachi 3:1

- 1. The formula "it is written" is common in the Gospels when the Hebrew Scriptures are quoted. How does this way of introducing quotations from the Scripture communicate their authority?
- 2. Who is the "messenger" mentioned here? Whose way is being prepared?
- 3. Why was it appropriate for a messenger to prepare the way for Christ's coming?
- 4. How does Mark's use of Malachi 3:1 point to the fact that Jesus is God?

### **GETTING DEEPER**

### Read Malachi 4:5-6

- 1. What is great about the coming judgment day of the Lord? What is dreadful?
- 2. What are the two optional ways people have to respond to the prophet Elijah, according to verse 6?
- 3. What do these verses reveal about the heart of God for people?

### **GETTING PERSONAL**

- 1. Describe the hope you feel when you are trusting in a promise, a foretelling, from the Lord. Give an example of such a promise, if you can.
- 2. Share about a time you were losing hope that a promise of God would come true for you. What did you do?
- 3. Do you find it easier to repent before God, or to reject Him? Why do think this is so?
- 4. What are ways we can reinforce our confidence in God's promises, when that confidence is slipping?
