GETTING STARTED

ICE BREAKER: If you could pick any other nation on earth to live, where would it be? Why?

KEY THOUGHT: Celebrate that God is King over all!

GETTING THE POINT

Read Psalm 47:1-4 (Stanza 1)

- 1. What does it mean to "fear" God as described in Psalm 47:2? How does this fear manifest in our relationship with Him?
- 2. How do verses 3-4 reflect God's "resume"? How does this inspire respect?
- 3. Why is it important to understand what living under God's Kingship is like, especially in light of current political concerns?

Read Psalm 47:5-9 (Stanzas 2 & 3)

- 4. The second stanza of Psalm 47 speaks of God being enthroned. How do we, as modern believers, recognize and honor God's Kingship and authority in our lives?
- 5. How many times do you count the phrase "Sing praises" in Stanza 2? Why the repetition?
- 6. This Psalm ends by declaring God as highly exalted. How does this truth help us put our earthly concerns into perspective?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Revelation 11:15-19

- 1. How does this future declaration of God's reign relate to Psalm 47?
- 2. What imagery here stirs you to respect God's authority?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. How should the knowledge that God is King over all influence our response to current events and political issues?
- 2. How can we balance influencing our current nation while not placing our ultimate hope in it?
- 3. What are some ways we can practice celebrating God's Kingship in our daily lives?
