- 4. What is the ultimate outcome of laying up treasure in heaven?

### Read Psalm 52:7

- 1. What two sources of refuge are contrasted in this verse?
- 2. What is the devastating outcome of seeking refuge in the wrong source? What does this mean for many in our world today?

## **GETTING PERSONAL**

- 1. On a scale of 1 to 10 with 1 being impoverished to the point of having no material goods, where do you fall on the "riches" scale?
- 2. Where do you see the most need for you personally: change in Attitude, Actions, or Ambition with regard to money?
- 3. What benefits do you see in this world for being generous with your finances? What benefits in the next world?
- 4. What is a way you can stretch in your generosity, particularly as we come into this holiday season when we are reminded of the generosity of God in sending His Son for us?
