GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 4:35-41

- 1. What is on "the other side" of the lake? (Hint: see Mark 5:20.)
- 2. Point out some similarities between this scene and Jonah 1. Point out some differences.
- 3. What three questions are in this passage? (Counting Jesus' two questions as one.) How does Jesus' question directly counter the first question of the disciples?
- 4. What similarities do you see between verse 39 and Mark 1:24-26? What is the significance of these similarities?
- 5. What is surprising about the disciples' response in verse 41?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Mark 1:14-15

- 1. In what way is Jesus bringing the Kingdom of God by crossing the Sea of Galilee?
- 2. What layers of meaning are included in the word "believe" here in verse 15?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. How likely are you to stay calm in a storm, knowing that Jesus has power over the chaos?
- 2. Do you justify fears in your life? How?
- 3. When have you allowed fear to "drive the bus" and overshadow your faith?
- 4. On a scale of 1 to 10, how much do you see yourself "on mission" with Jesus in reaching outsiders? What could help you to be more "on mission"?
- 5. Tell about a difficult "lab session" God has taken you through to grow your faith. What did you learn?
- 6. How do you know that Jesus did not give up on His followers for their lack of faith in Mark's narrative? What reassurance do you take from this?
