GETTING STARTED

KEY THOUGHT: "For Jesus There's No Such Thing As A Lost Cause"

GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 5:1-10

- 1. How do you think the people interacted with this man?
- 2. How do we see Christ's power and supremacy on display in this passage?

Read Mark 5:11-17

- 3. What does this passage teach us about the value of one human soul?
- 4. What would the people think after seeing the man go from demon-possessed to being in his right mind?
- 5. Why do the people fear and beg Jesus to leave after such an amazing powerful act?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Mark 5:18-20

- 1. Why does Jesus not allow the man to join Him in the boat?
- 2. What is the result of the man's testimony amongst the people? How do the people go from sending Jesus away to marveling at the man's message?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. How do you respond to the people in your life who society might label as a "lost cause"?
- 2. What has it cost you to follow Jesus? What were/are you willing to give up to follow Jesus?
- 3. What in your life are you begging Jesus not to interfere with? Why are you resistant?
- 4. Where is Christ sending you to bring the hope of the Gospel?
