GETTING STARTED

ICE BREAKER: What has been one of your hardest experiences of rejection?

KEY THOUGHT: Rejection leads to expansion

GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 6:1-6

- 1. What do you think was the reason that Jesus' hometown rejected instead of celebrating Him?
- 2. How could a lack of belief stand in the way of Jesus doing miracles in Nazareth?

Read Mark 6:7-13

- 3. How are the apostles carrying out what Jesus called them to do? (Hint: see Mark 3:14-15).
- 4. What is the significance of "shaking the dust off" the disciples' feet?
- 5. How does this "sending" by Jesus reflect an expansion of the Kingdom?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Acts 7:51-53

- 1. How does the rejection of Jesus in Nazareth actually validate His role as prophet?
- 2. What does rejection of prophets indicate about the ones doing the rejecting?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. How do you typically respond when rejected by others?
- 2. Who have you known (no need to use names) who had a hard time "adapting" their view of Jesus from their first impression which did not include His identity as God or Messiah?
- 3. What does rejection look like today when we share our faith in Christ?
- 4. How does the parable of the sower (Mark 4) relate to the fact that some will not trust in Christ for salvation?
- 5. How does it help (or not) for you to reframe rejection in the context of sharing your faith, as re-direction?
