- 2. What is right in Peter's response to Jesus in verse 29? What is missing?

Read Mark 8:31-9:1

- 3. What was radically surprising about Jesus' teaching in verse 31?
- 4. How does Peter's rebuke in verse 32 reveal his lack of understanding of the term "Christ"?
- 5. How would you summarize Jesus' teaching in verses 34-38?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Daniel 7:13-14

- 1. Why would these verses cause us to think the "Son of Man" was powerful and triumphant?
- 2. What did Jesus add to the understanding of "Son of Man" in Mark 8:31?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. Why do examples of powerful and strong leaders appeal to us?
- 2. In what ways do our life journeys correspond to the life journey of Jesus through suffering?
- 3. What makes it so hard for our Self to let go of things in order to take up our cross?
- 4. What benefit does Jesus promise for those who lay down their life?
- 5. Do you think it is harder to say no to Self in our culture, or in a culture with more persecution? Why do you answer this way?
