#### **GETTING STARTED**

## **GETTING THE POINT**

# Read Mark 10:32-45

- 1. Describe the WHAT of the Gospel in verses 33-34. What is shocking about this description?
- 2. Describe the WHY of the Gospel in verse 45. What is shocking about the "Son of Man" giving His life as a ransom?
- 3. How does Jesus turn the world's view of greatness on its head?

## Read Mark 10:46-52

- 4. With what specific actions does Bartimaeus respond to Jesus as a model disciple?
- 5. How do the two scenes of Jesus healing a blind man (here and 8:22-26) form a fitting frame around the three instances of the disciples misunderstanding Jesus' predictions of His death?

#### **GETTING DEEPER**

### Read Galatians 2:20

- What similarities do you see between Galatians 2:20 and Mark 10:45?
- 2. Describe the sense here in which we are "crucified" with Christ.

#### **GETTING PERSONAL**

- 1. What is your initial reaction to James and John's request immediately following Jesus' prediction of His death? In what sense can you relate to them?
- 2. In practical terms what do you think Jesus meant in verses 43-44?
- 3. What concerns you personally about the idea of the Gospel leading "to death?" In what way does that sound freeing?
- 4. If engagement with the Gospel is a continuum between (initial) decision and death (to self) where do you think you are on that continuum?
