GETTING STARTED

ICE BREAKER: Tell about a time you needed access but were barred from entering.

KEY THOUGHT: Access to God is about to radically expand

GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 11:7-11

- 1. What is the significance of this dramatic welcome for Jesus?
- 2. Why do you think Mark tells us that He "looked around at everything" in the Temple?

Read Mark 11:12-21

- 3. How does the understanding that fig trees produce fruit before leaves explain Jesus' curse?
- 4. What is the meaning of the "Markan sandwich": fig tree / Temple upset / fig tree?
- 5. Read verses 22-25. How will prayer be more accessible after Jesus than it is in the Temple?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Isaiah 56:6-7

- 1. What do these words, written 800 years before Christ, say about God's heart for all peoples?
- 2. How do Jesus' actions in Mark 11 work to bring these words to fruition?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. What is surprising about Jesus' Temple upset at the start of His Passion week? In what way was it an appropriate start?
- 2. Imagine you are a Gentile approaching the Temple and you encounter the "keep out on penalty of death" sign. How would you have felt? What would you have done?
- 3. Were Jesus' actions in overturning the tables effective? Why or why not? What are His actions foreshadowing?
- 4. How does it make you feel toward Jesus that He valued you so much He was willing to give His own life to give you access to God?
- 5. How much do you value access to God in prayer? What would cause you to value it more?
