GETTING STARTED

ICE BREAKER: Tell about a time when you went against an authority, to your detriment!

KEY THOUGHT: Rejection of Jesus leads to destruction

GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 11:27-33

- 1. How did the religious leaders think they were trapping Jesus by their question?
- 2. How does Jesus assert His authority in responding to the religious leaders?
- 3. How did Jesus' question expose the hearts of the religious leaders?

Read Mark 12:1-12

- 4. What is so surprising about the tenants' handling of the servants who come to collect rent?
- 5. How does this surprise make the decision of the owner to send his beloved son all the more surprising?
- 6. What were the religious leaders afraid of with regard to the people (11:32; 12:12)?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Isaiah 5:1-2

- 1. What similarities do you see between the Isaiah verses and the opening of Jesus' story?
- 2. What is the irony that Jesus referenced a real prophet as He told a story about prophets?

GETTING PERSONAL

- In what way(s) does this scene challenge your view of Jesus?
- 2. How does fear of losing power show up in your own life?
- 3. The treatment by the tenants of the servants and son is unquestionably horrible. In what ways might you, to a lesser degree, show disrespect or rebellion against God's authority?
- 4. What is a practical way you can more deeply submit to the authority of Jesus?
