CARE MINISTRY 2023 REPORT

20...21...16 are key numbers when relating to Grace Point's Care Ministry.

Twenty years ago, Grace Point established a caregiving ministry to serve the body of Christ at Grace Point and to supplement the care given by the pastoral staff. Currently, there are 21 trained, committed and compassionate men and women who are active care ministers serving in 16 various ministry areas.

In October 2023, six individuals completed the two-session Orientation Training. The information, tips, support and guidelines they received prepared the trainees to serve, as they decided, in any of the following ministry areas:




The Leadership Team is hopeful to offer a more comprehensive six-session Training in early 2025 to prepare new caregivers to serve in Confidential Care Relationships, Prayer Partnering and Mental Health Ministry.

Our meeting schedule in 2023 incorporated ZOOM format for the first time along with the usual in-person gatherings. Winter weather and night driving are no longer factors determining being able to meet. In addition to encouraging each other in our care relationships, updates from each ministry area are presented. On occasion, salvation testimonies were shared, and Pastor Jason attended to meet the Team and get acquainted with the Care Ministry.

Two significant ministries launched in 2023: Mental Health Ministry and Special Needs Support. The Mental Health Ministry seeks to support families touched by mental health issues. This is a strong initiative led by trained folks who have or are walking the "Mental Health path." The other new ministry is Special Needs. Two care ministers have partnered with the Grace Point Children's Ministry to support families with a special needs child. Although very new, both of these ministries have a solid beginning and are developing comprehensive programs.

Over these 20 years, the GP Care Ministry continually seeks God's direction as to how to best serve the Grace Point community. We are delighted to witness the Lord working and to be His agents-of-care in the lives of individuals. "We are the caregiver; God is the curegiver."



WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Women's Ministry was blessed to have several hundred women in all seasons of life attending various Bible studies and discussion groups offered throughout the year, including the study of Elizabeth's life in the Summer of 2023. Our Bible studies are the heartbeat of our ministry, and we are so thankful for those who commit their time to gather and grow in the Lord and His Word.

Our Quilters Ministry continues to meet on the third Saturday of each month and donates the quilts they make in Christ's name to various ministries in our area to bless children who are ill or in need. Women's Outreach & Fellowship creates crafts and blankets to share the kindness and Gospel of Christ to children in need in Philadelphia and beyond.

We hosted our first annual SerenDIPity ~ Celebrating Dips, Faith & Friendship in November 2023. It was a fun evening of fellowship, dips, friendship, and light-hearted competition. This will become an annual event.

The Women's *Christmas Tea* in December 2023 featured a wonderful speaker – Julie Henning, who shared her testimony of growing up in Asia and being adopted by Pearl Buck here in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. About 200 women attended the tea, and many invited friends who heard the Gospel through Julie's message.

The Women's Retreat in April 2024 was called *Christ Incomparable*, and the women were refreshed, encouraged and challenged with teaching from God's Word on the seven *I Am* statements of Christ in the book of John. Our teachers were Grace Point's very own Lynn Ely and Mindy Benjamin. The weekend was also filled with sweet fellowship, yummy meals, rest, games, walks on the beach, and beautiful sunsets!

We give God the glory for all the wonderful things He is doing in the hearts and lives of our women!. "I delight in Your decrees; I will not neglect Your Word." (Psalm 119:16)

STUDENT MINISTRY

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. "The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in Him." (Lamentations 3:22-24)

Great is God's Faithfulness... It has been a joy to serve at GP Students over the last four plus years. I've seen God move in incredible ways in the hearts of our young people. It's a joy to highlight the steadfast love of the Lord.

God has done some incredible work in the lives of our young people over the last four years. In first couple of years, we were running a combined youth group averaging around 20–30 students in attendance. It was encouraging to see them grow in their faith and love for Christ. As time went on, these students started to get excited about inviting their friends, and we began to see new students and new faces enter the ministry. As God provided a harvest of students, our Student Center was overflowing, and we needed a solution. Our team decided to provide a High School and Middle School Youth Group. The Lord blessed us with additional youth leaders to shepherd the ministry. As a result, our number of students started to increase rapidly.

Currently, we average around 30-40 middle schoolers and 30-40 high schoolers each Sunday night, with many of the weekly-attending students coming from unchurched families. The Gospel is impacting their lives, and we pray these students take the Gospel home with them. We currently have 130 students who have entered our doors throughout the

ministry year. Over the last two years, a handful of students have put their faith in Christ and 15 students were baptized, with an additional 5-10 asking about getting baptized. The Lord is working on our student's hearts. Each week God provides opportunities to meet our students in the trials of life and point them to the hope of Christ. Pray for our youth leaders as they walk with students through significant struggles. Pray that our students cling to Jesus.

Exciting upcoming opportunities... We have been building a relationship with *Hope Rescue Mission* in Reading, PA, to jumpstart our missions' opportunities for students. One of our youth leaders traveled to Panama with a Grace Point team to investigate specific opportunities for our students. We also are excited for our upcoming Winter Retreat at Camp Orchard Hill on February 14-16, 2025, and Summer Retreats at Harvey Cedars during the last two weeks of July. There are many other events going on including weekly Bible studies, youth groups, Yes! Day With PJ, Harvest Party, Christmas Party and so much more. Students are welcome to join us anytime.

Please pray for us as we partner with parents as they disciple their children. Pray for our students as they face an onslaught of struggles this world throws at them. Trust that they would cling to the new mercies God provides every morning. Thank you to all who have supported the ministry. We are grateful and humbled to carry out the work of the Lord amongst the teens in our community.
