GETTING THE POINT

Read Mark 14:1-2

- 1. What is the irony of the Passover as backdrop to the religious rulers' plot to kill Jesus?
- 2. Describe the risk of "uproar" if the rulers do not act with stealth.

Read Mark 14:3-11

- 3. How does the value of this gift of nard reflect on the woman who brought it?
- 4. How does the "scolding" of the onlookers contrast with Jesus' response?
- 5. Why do you think Mark repeats the phrase "She has done" three times? (14:6, 8, 9)
- 6. How does Judas' offer to betray Jesus connect to Mark 14:1-2?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Matthew 25:35-40

- 1. In what way can giving to the poor today be seen as giving to Jesus?
- 2. Why do you suppose Jesus identified with those who are marginalized in our world?

GETTING PERSONAL

- 1. What is your reaction when the onlookers "scold" the woman? What is your reaction when Jesus defends her?
- 2. Why was it significant that this ointment was applied to Jesus in preparation for His burial?
- 3. What are some of the motivations we might have for giving a gift to Jesus? How do you know when you are giving a gift sacrificially, from your heart?
- 4. What other ways can we give to Jesus today besides giving to the poor?
- 5. How do we receive the "commendation" of Jesus today?
