GETTING STARTED

ICE BREAKER: What has been the neatest thing you’ve seen in the nighttime sky?

KEY THOUGHT: *The world offers promises it cannot keep. God has never broken one.*

GETTING THE POINT

Read Genesis 15:1-6

1. Why does Abram seem to flip flop in trusting and not trusting God’s promise? What does this reveal about humanity?
2. Abram brought some very challenging personal questions to the Lord. How does God walk with him through these questions? What does it show about God’s Fatherly care for His people?
3. God always wants Abram’s focus on God’s truth, what visual reminders does Abram use to communicate this? (Genesis 13:14-16, 15:5)

Read Genesis 15:7-21

4. What is a covenant? What’s different about the covenant God makes with Abram and the typical covenant of the time?
5. What is the outcome if God were to break the covenant with Abram?
6. What character attributes of God are on display in this passage?

GETTING DEEPER

Read Hebrews 6:13-14, 2nd Corinthians 5:21

1. How does the Abrahamic Covenant point to the New Covenant?
2. How is one made righteous today?

GETTING PERSONAL

1. What promises are you clinging to? Promises from the world? Promises from God?
2. How has God walked with you kindly as a Father? How has He been patient towards you?
3. How can trusting God’s promises help you move forward when the outcome is unclear?
4. In what way is your life a blessing to others around you? How are you glorifying God? Who are you telling the good news of Jesus to?

PRAY...

That we will trust God’s promises rather than the lies of the world, recognizing He is faithful.
