Sign of the Times: A Study of Revelation | Are we living in the end times?

Conversation Guide

Grab a few friends or reflect on these questions by yourself to apply this weekend's message to your daily life.

1. Do you think we are living in the end times? Why or why not?
2. When you think about "the end," what sorts of feelings come up in you? Why do you think that is?
3. What does it look like to fear God? Does that phrase feel strange or familiar? How does your understanding of fear shape the way you relate to God?
4. If the end times make you uneasy, how could you reframe your perspective to be full of hope? If you're already feeling hopeful about the end times, how does that anchor you today?
5. What does it mean to be ready for the return of Jesus? What's one thing you can do today to prepare for it?
6. Spend some time in prayer, telling God about how you feel

about the end times. If you're worried, ask him to bring peace. Be honest with your doubts and allow him to deepen your trust in him. Thank him for the plans he has for the future and for inviting you to be a part of them.

Key Scripture

Revelation 1:4

This letter is from John to the seven churches in the province of Asia.
