Sermon Notes

The Abundant Life Hebrews 5:11-6:8

What does it mean to have life in abundance? John 10:10, "A thief comes to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance."

Ephesians 2:4-10

Life becomes abundant when our hearts grow in love and closeness with Jesus.

Hebrews Audience: Jews who had been saved by Jesus but were tempted to drift from Jesus.

I. (5:11-14) The Problem of Spiritual Immaturity

(Vs 11) The problem of spiritual immaturity was connected to their laziness. (Vs 12-13) Spiritual immaturity is hearing, comprehending, and acknowledging the message of Jesus but not loving Him.

(Vs 14) Spiritual maturity is a commitment to discern between good and evil because you love Jesus.

II. (6:1-8) The Call to Spiritual Maturity

(6:1a) Christians are encouraged to press on to spiritual maturity and warned of the inherent dangers of neglecting to cultivate their love for Jesus.

(6:1b-3) We won't achieve spiritual maturity by simply practicing religious activity; spiritual maturity is experienced by loving Jesus. God will help us love Him!

(Vs 4-6) There are 3 predominant ways to view this passage:

- 1) There are people who believe this text teaches that genuine believers can lose their salvation: Impossible!
- 2) It is possible that this text teaches that a genuine believer can lose rewards.
- 3) It is possible that this text teaches that a person can be exposed to the gospel, acknowledge it, but never truly experience it.

(Vs 7-8) A person who loves Jesus will live an abundant and fruitful life.

What must we do? (6:1) We must return to Jesus and grow in our love for Him!


