An Anchor of Hope Hebrews 6:13-20

If you've ever experienced feelings of hopelessness, then you will appreciate the value of hope.

The world views hope as a matter of probability. (Think about weather reports.)
The bible views hope as an example of certainty. (Think about the resurrection.)

How can we experience the full assurance of hope while walking in a worrisome world?

I. (Vs 13-18) We can trust in the promises of God because they never fail.

A. (Vs 13-15) An example of the power and dependability of God's promises is found in Abraham.

B. (Vs 16-18) God doubled down on His promises to Abraham by guaranteeing them with an oath.

We can trust in God's promises because He never fails!

II. (Vs 19-20) We have guaranteed hope because Jesus is our forerunner.

A. (Vs 19) Jesus is our anchor.

The circumstances surrounding your situation will not shake the solidity of the Son of God. He is a solid anchor for the soul and we are secure in him!

(Vs 20) Jesus is our forerunner.

So what? (Vs 18) "We who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to seize the hope set before us." Let us hold on to the hope secured by Jesus!

Psalm 94:18, "If I say, 'My foot is slipping,' your faithful love will support me, Lord."

We have hope in Jesus that is worthy of our confidence and commitment.
The hope of a better tomorrow is based upon God's proven accomplishment in the past.
The world hopes for better things while believers hope in Jesus guarantees better things!

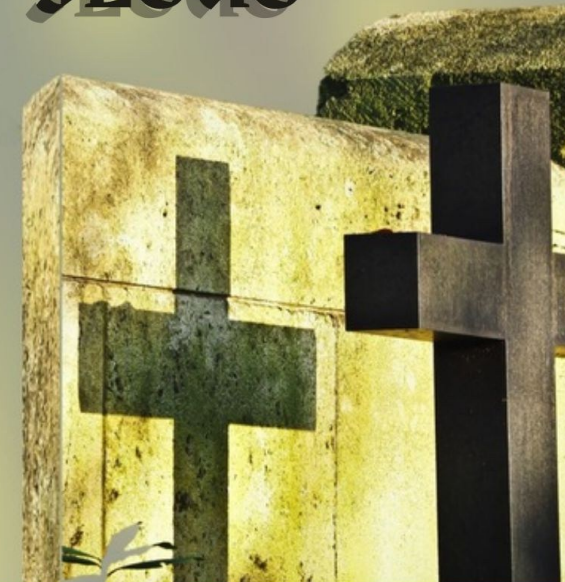
