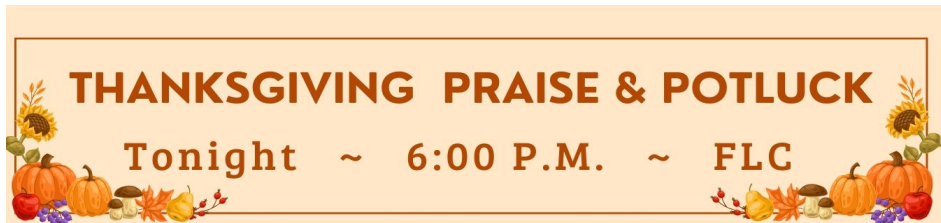

Jesus is Worthy - Part 1

Matthew 13:44-46

This week and next, I want to share with you the inestimable value of God's kingdom. Why should a person surrender their life to Jesus? There is nothing in this world of more value than having a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

What is the kingdom of heaven?

The kingdom of heaven is the life changing rule and reign of Jesus Christ.

Structure of the Hidden Treasure (v. 44) Structure of the Pearl of Great Price (vv. 45-46)

Scene 1: A man finds a treasure.	Scene 1: A merchant finds a priceless pearl.
Scene 2: The man joyfully sells everything.	Scene 2: The merchant sells everything.
Scene 3: The man buys the field.	Scene 3: Merchant buys the priceless pearl.

The teaching of the two parables focuses on the value of the kingdom of Heaven.

1. (Vs 44, 46) The kingdom of heaven is of immeasurable value.
2. (Vs 44) The immeasurable value of the kingdom brings great joy.
3. (Vs 44, 46) The kingdom of heaven calls for a sacrificial response.

If we lose everything for Jesus and we get Jesus, then we have gained everything!

How might this apply to our lives as followers of Jesus?

Living for Jesus is so valuable that we joyfully surrender everything to Him.

Where is your treasure?
Matthew 16:19-24

Jesus is worthy because He is the ultimate treasure that satisfies the longing of our heart.
