

A Supreme Priest

Hebrews 7

Before we broke for the Christmas holidays, we studied Hebrews 6:20, which reads, “Jesus has entered there (the inner sanctuary behind the curtain) on our behalf as a forerunner, because he has become a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.”

Hebrews 7 provides the commentary necessary to understand the relationship between Melchizedek’s priesthood, the Levitical priesthood, and Jesus.

If Hebrews 7 was a sermon, Psalm 110 would be the text, and the superiority of Jesus would be the main point!

I. (Vs 1-10) Melchizedek’s priesthood was a shadow of a greater priest to come.

II. (Vs 11-28) Jesus is a more superior priest than Melchizedek.

There are two reasons Jesus is a superior priest:

1) (Vs 20-22) Promise - Jesus is a priest with an oath from the Lord.

2) (Vs 23-24) Permanence - Jesus holds a position of priest without term limits.

How does Jesus as my high priest impact my daily life?

1) (Vs 25a) In Jesus we always have a redeemer.


2) (Vs 25b-28) In Jesus we always have an advocate.
