SAVE THE DATE: Illumination Station VBS June 1-5 from 8 am to noon for children who have completed Kinder through 5th grade.



How can we overcome feelings of guilt that can sabotage a life of faith?
Grace terminates the disgrace of guilt so we can serve the living God!

Hebrews 9 helps us comprehend the accomplishment of grace in the life of a person who loves Jesus and walks with Him by grace through faith.

I. (Vs 1-10) The old covenant pointed to a better and perfect new covenant.

Problem: The old covenant provided a means through the Levitical sacrifices for a person to be purified from physical defilement, but it did not bring forgiveness of sin and spiritual cleansing.

II. (Vs 11-14a) The blood of Jesus cleanses our conscience of sin's guilt.

- 1) (Vs 11-12a) Jesus is enthroned in heaven as our High Priest.
- 2) (Vs 12b-14a) Jesus gave an ultimate price by surrendering His own blood.

Solution: Guilt before God is fully overcome by faith in Jesus!


III. (Vs 15b) We are cleansed to serve God by the power of His grace.
