### MISSIONS



The same God who warns of judgment has provided the remedy in His Son. The warning is real—but so is the rescue. And as we turn to this passage, we are hearing not just a caution, but a loving and urgent call: Don't reject Jesus!

Hebrews 10 is a chapter that encourages followers of Jesus to hold on to their confidence in Christ.

- 1) Hebrews 10:10, 14 – We are sanctified by Jesus' sacrifice once for all time.
- 2) Hebrews 10:15 – The Holy Spirit promises forgiveness under the new covenant.
- 3) Hebrews 10:19-25 – Jesus opens the door and holds it open to God's presence.
- 4) Hebrews 10:26 – "For" connects this passage to the preceding promises.

There is a problem being addressed in Hebrews 10:19-25: It's a warning.

### **I. (Vs 26-30) If a person rejects Jesus, then they experience terrifying judgment.**

The writer of Hebrews is warning us that there is no back up plan to Jesus Christ!

### **II. (Vs 31) It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.**

- 1) *We should fear God because He is alive.*
- 2) *We should fear God because He is the solution to our greatest need.*
- 3) *We should fear God because we will fall into His hands.*


