

In the same way a muscle is strengthened by a commitment to physical exercise, our spiritual life is strengthened when we commit to living by faith moment by moment of each day.

### Question: What does it mean to walk by faith?

Hebrews 11:1, faith is "...the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen."

There are two phrases describing faith that essentially say the same thing:

1) "...the reality of what is hoped for"

The Greek word translated 'reality' means assurance and carries the idea of substance, certainty, or foundation.

We trust in God by faith because the hope secured by His promises is more solid than the ground beneath our feet.

2) "...the proof of what is not seen"

The Greek word translated 'proof' carries the idea of evidence, conviction, or inner confidence.

Faith is living today with joy and confidence because we are absolutely certain that the hope God promised for tomorrow is coming.

(Vs 2) Our spiritual ancestors lived by faith and won God's approval.

(Vs 3) A product of our faith is the conviction that God created all things out of nothing and now sustains all things by the power of His Word.


