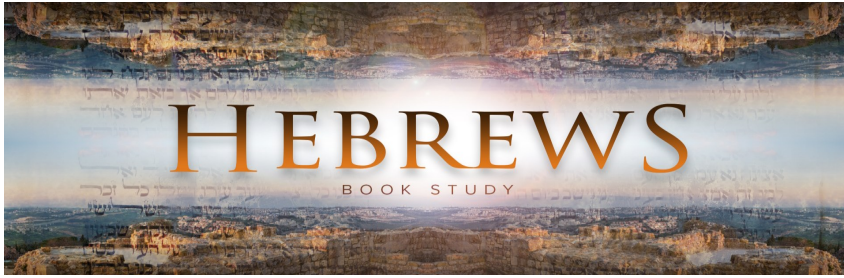


MISSIONS

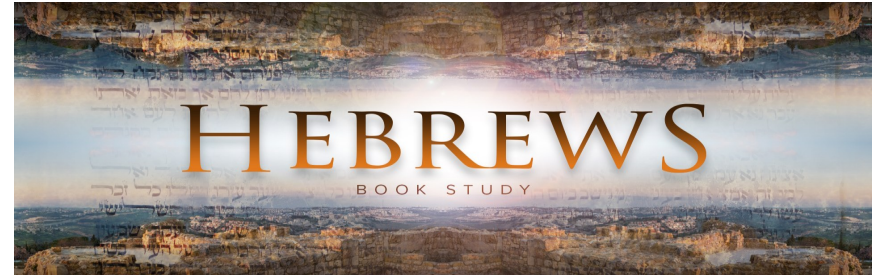
