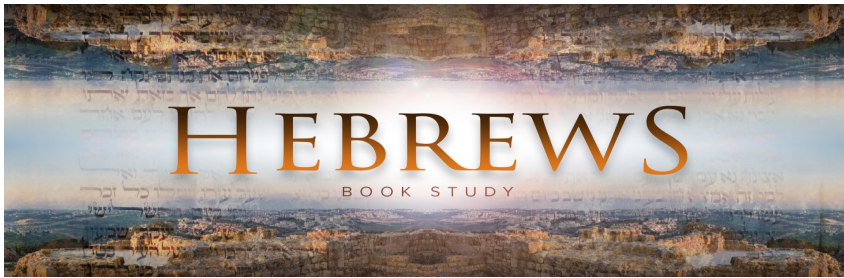
 **SENIOR ADULTS**

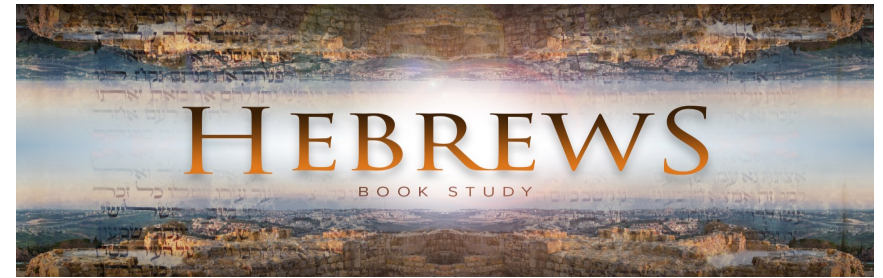
