**(Vs 22-23a)** Jesus and the disciples are in a boat on the Sea of Galilee, headed toward the region of the Gerasenes.

**(Vs 23b)** “Then” a fierce windstorm came down on the lake; the boat was swamped; everyone was in danger.

**Don’t forget the truth: There are lessons in the storms.**  
Storms are God’s workshop to chisel and craft spiritual heroes.

**I. (Vs 24) Jesus provides for his disciples in their time of greatest need.**

**II. (Vs 25a) Jesus addresses the deficiency of the disciple’s faith.**  
Jesus addresses their fundamental problem, which is a discipleship issue.

It manifested itself in various ways:

- They forgot His promise.
- They focused on the storm more than the Savior.
- They forgot previous faithfulness.
- They failed to connect His power to His care

**III. (Vs 25b) The disciples grappled with the divinity of Jesus.**

We can find peace amid life’s storms by understanding a few truths about the character of Jesus:
