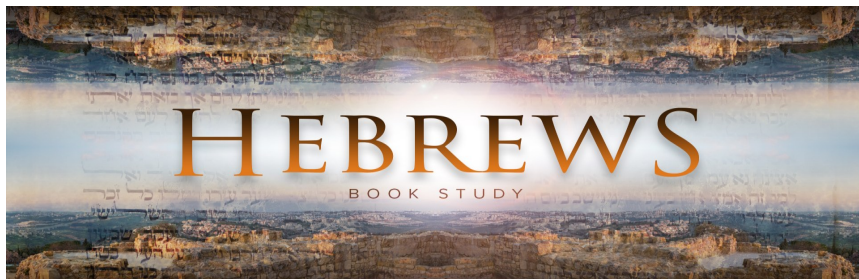

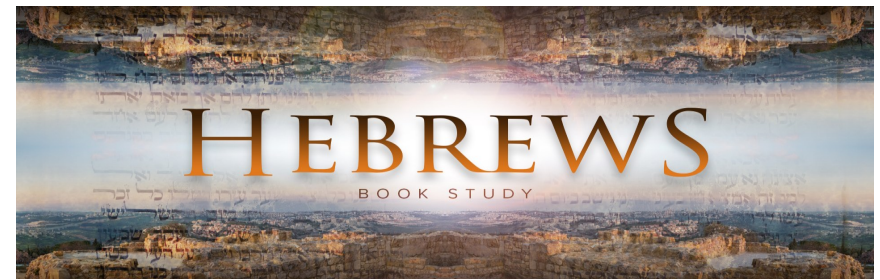
What is stable in an unstable world? God! The faithfulness of God is a most comforting, encouraging, and compelling component of the Christian life.

The main purpose for the book of Hebrews is to encourage a group of Jesus-followers to finish faithfully despite facing difficulty and being tempted to drift.

- II. (Vs 8-16) **Guard against the danger of departing from the gospel of Jesus.**
- III. (Vs 17) **Submit to pastoral leadership as a testimony to the power of the gospel.**

 - 3) Comprehend the burden of a pastor.
 - 4) Rejoice in God's purpose for a pastor.
