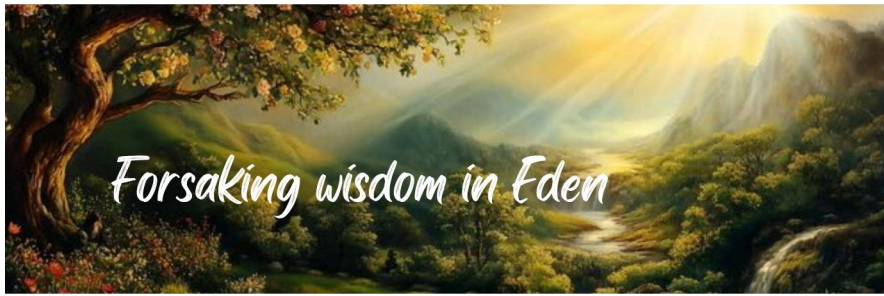

When our spiritual ancestors chose to forsake wisdom in Eden, the world experienced catastrophic consequences that continue to have an impact on us all today.

- 2) (Vs 1-3) **The devil wants us to distort God's Word.**
- 3) (Vs 4-6) **The devil wants us to deny God's Word.**
- 4) (Vs 7-8) **The devil wants to drive us away from God into deeper darkness.**

The gospel is the story of God replacing fig leaves with grace. Humanity's religion says, 'Cover yourself.' Christ says, 'I have covered you'.

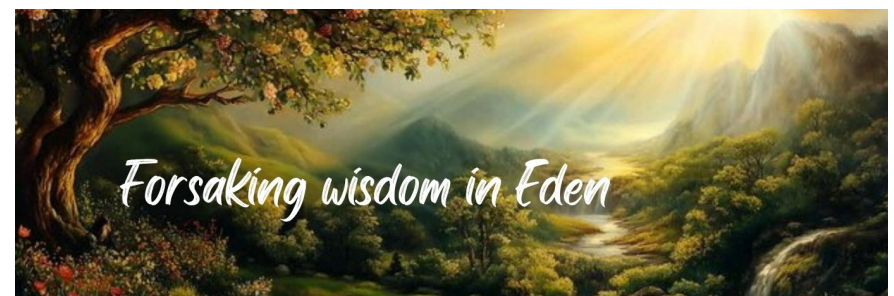
