**(Vs 20-21) We can gratefully embrace our earthly citizenship,  
but our highest allegiance belongs to King Jesus.**

- 1) We have dual citizenship. (Vs 20)  
Our earthly citizenship shapes our responsibilities,  
but our heavenly citizenship defines our identity.
- 2) Jesus hasn't abandoned us; He is coming to get us! (Vs 21)  
The resurrection of Jesus is not merely proof that we  
will live forever, it is the pattern of what we will  
become.

**(Vs 4:1) Our King's call to action is to stand firm in His calling.**

- 2) Living with wisdom, integrity, and Godly character.  
(Philippians 1:27)
