The Folly of Self-Reliance 2 Kings 5:1-15

(v. 1-5) – A great man with a grave condition

(v. 6-12) – Wrong directions, a bad attitude, and a big waste of time

(v. 13-15) – Faithful obedience to God results in a changed life

Main Idea: Because God delights in extending His grace to the humble, we must abandon self-reliance and submit to His Word in faith.

Like Naaman, we can delight in God's grace by:

- 1) Laying down our pride to receive God's grace
(2 Kings 5:1-12; James 4:6)
- 2) Trusting in God's Word
 - a. Will we reason with what we think is true? (2 Kings 5:10)
 - b. Will we submit to the Word of God? (2 Kings 5:14)
- 3) Responding to grace with worship (2 Kings 5:15; Hebrews 12:28-29)

What we couldn't possibly do for ourselves has been made evident in the grace God has given us through the blood of Jesus Christ.
