Trusting in the Lord Proverbs 3

Are you trusting in the Lord with _____?

Trusting God is hard, but trusting God is worth it.

When life heats up, God's presence helps us regulate our sense of fear, anxiety, and panic to help us overcome and walk with faithfulness.

What does it mean to trust God?

1. Abide (vs 1—4) Treasure His teaching
2. Rely (vs 5 – 8) Walk in His ways

What happens when we actively trust God?

1. Empowerment (vs 9 – 12) Give Faithfully and Generously
 - A. Trust and Stewardship go hand-in-hand.
2. Freedom (vs 13 – 26) Confidence vs Worry
 - A. Wisdom gives perspective in uncertainty, stability in difficulty, a confidence in an unpredictable world because it is rooted in the character of God.
3. Motivation (vs 27 – 35) Humility over Pride
 - A. Humility cultivates peace, generates generosity, and diffuses animosity.

Wisdom is not found in controlling life, but trusting in the One who already does.
