## **Sermon Notes**

The Danger of Drifting Hebrews 2:1-4

Hebrews 2:1-4 is one of five warning passages in the book of Hebrews.

### I. (Vs 1) Danger: The danger is drifting from Jesus.

Since Jesus is superior to everything, we must pay attention to Him, so we do not drift from Him.

How can we know when we are drifting or losing focus on Jesus?

- 1) There is no desire for intimacy with God.
- 2) Careless about studying Scripture.
- 3) Indifferent of kingdom ministry.
- 4) Do not pray.
- 5) Irritated by spiritual intervention.
- 6) Distance from people of God.
- 7) God is not a priority in the rhythm of life.

Drifting from Jesus is detrimental to experiencing God's best for our life.

## a) (Vs 2-3a) Warning: The warning is do not neglect the Word of God.

There are dire consequences experienced by anyone who fails to focus on Jesus.

- \*Rejecting Jesus' salvation leads to eternal punishment in hell.
- \*Failing to nurture a relationship with Jesus leads to discipline and loss of reward.

#### b) (Vs 3b-4) Truth: Focus on the Word because it is the truth of God.

It makes no sense to ignore the truth of God's gospel invitation.

- \*The gospel comes from God, himself.
- \*The gospel was confirmed by eyewitness account.
- \*The gospel was corroborated by a miraculous move of the Holy Spirit.

If we spiritually drift, God's discipline is strong, but His grace is stronger. Turn to Jesus!




