A Heart of Faithfulness Proverbs 5-7

This story is shared to expose the threat of the enemy and the scandal of sin, while raising the mirror of self-examination to experience grace.

Proverbs 4:23 – “Guard your heart because it is the source of life.”

To guard a heart of faithfulness:

1. Recognize the danger of temptation,
2. Learn how to overcome temptation, and
3. Remember the tragedy of giving in to temptation.

Chapter 5: We are warned about the danger of temptation.

- The enemy wants us to walk in disobedience, doubt God’s way is the best way, and lead us down a path toward destruction.
- Temptation is listening to the lie that God’s way isn’t the best way and walking in disobedience.

Chapter 6: We can overcome temptation by guarding a heart of wisdom.

There are at least 3 ways to guard a heart of wisdom and honor God in a world full of temptation:

- **(Vs 20 – 21):** Treasure God’s Word
- **(Vs 22):** Trust God’s Word
- **(Vs 23):** Submit to God’s Word

Chapter 7: We must remember the testimony of those who failed to resist temptation.
