A Story of Two Tables Proverbs 9

Solomon tells the story of two tables (the table of wisdom and the table of folly) to help us examine our hearts and respond faithfully to God's invitation to wisdom.

I. (Vs 1-6) Wisdom offers a seat at the table of life.

II. (Vs 7-12) The invitation to Wisdom's table points to the invitation of Jesus.

When you are a guest at Jesus' table, there are promised blessings:

*Presence = John 6:35 "I am the bread of life, come to Jesus and never hunger."

*Rest = Matthew 11:28 Jesus invites the weary to come to Him and find rest.

*Life = John 10:10 Jesus gives life 'in abundance'. John 17:3

*Hope = Revelation 19:9 The marriage supper of the Lamb!

III. (Vs 13-18) Folly offers a seat at the table of death.

The question isn't whether you will sit at a table. Every day, you're accepting someone's invitation. The question is: Whose invitation will you accept?

Come to the table of wisdom, where Jesus leads us into abundant life!
