Wisdom and Plans Proverbs 16:1-9

Wisdom makes plans but submits them to the sovereignty of God.

- I. (Vs 1, 9) Wisdom encourages us to make plans.**
 - A. A gameplan to accomplish things for His glory is wise.
 - B. Proverbs 24:27 – Prioritize planning before a large project.
 - C. It is wise to prepare, pray, and pursue plans.

- II. (Vs 2) Wisdom calls us to examine the motive of our plans.**
 - A. Selfishness vs Pleasing God

- III. (Vs 3-8) Wisdom recognizes God's sovereignty over our plans.**
 - A. God's ultimate authority is over everything.
 - B. Evil doesn't escape His purposes or judgment.
 - C. Sovereignty isn't to fear, but rather is something His children can rest in.

- IV. (Vs 9) Wisdom makes no assumption that tomorrow will come.**

When seeking God's will for your life remember:

1. If it is not unbiblical or disobedient, then do it for the glory of God.
2. Discern God's giftedness in your life and serve Him in that capacity.
3. Make plans but allow God to work them out for His glory.

Plans change, but God never changes. Keep the plan of God your priority and pursue His purpose, and He will work everything out for His glory while we experience the joy of His presence.
