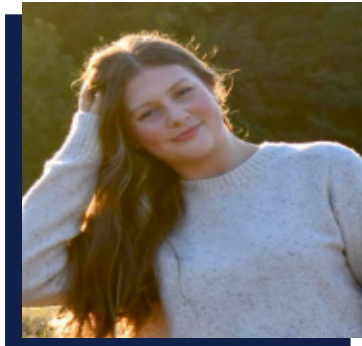
## Marley McCarty
