WHY HOST HOMES?

We value the time that our staff are able to spend in your home! We believe that there is immense value for our college students to be a part of your family for a week, and our hope is that our staff are a blessing to you as you are a blessing to us. We're so grateful for our host homes as they allow us to do ministry this summer!

WHO?

Three or more college students of the same gender. There is no max capacity of the number of staffers that you can host.

WHERE?

Each person will sleep in their own bed, no matter the size. We travel with plenty of air mattresses, so just let us know how many air mattresses you would need if applicable! We ask that staff do not sleep in common areas or share a bedroom or bathroom with a member of your family.

HOW LONG?

Staff would arrive Saturday evening (7/11) and depart the following Saturday morning (7/18) for a total of 7 nights in your home.

WHAT ABOUT FOOD?

Our host homes provide breakfast each morning - we get up early, so things that we can grab and go on the way out are great! Also, we ask that you provide dinner for our staff 3 nights (usually Monday, Wednesday and Friday) during their stay.

WHAT ABOUT CARS?

Our staff will be picked up and dropped off on a host home route each morning and evening! We leave early to be at the host church by 7am and will return each evening either before or after dinner based on the specific day. There's no need to transport staff at any point during the week.
