Opener

If you had to pick, would you want a billion dollars but be alone or would you want to be surrounded by true, biblical community?

Read

Mark 1:16-18; Mark 3:13-14; Mark 3:32-35; Galatians 4:4-7;

Main Points

- 1. Jesus said the new community he was creating is a family the church isn't a building or an event, it's a family of people not based on our blood, but based on the blood of Jesus that redeemed us.
- 2. When we truly understand grace, we engage in relationships radically different.
- 3. Grace-filled relationships are accepting instead of judging.
- 4. Grace-filled relationships are honest instead of hiding.
- 5. Grace-filled relationships are encouraging instead of exhausting.
- 6. Grace-filled relationships are forgiving instead of withholding.
- 7. Grace-filled relationships are growing instead of pretending.
