Opener

Who is one person who has poured into your life and shown you Jesus?

Read

Acts 2:42-47; 1 Peter 2:2;

Main Points

- 1. Out of devotion to Jesus, there were four characteristics that the early Christians were marked by: (1) Learning Truth, (2) Caring Relationships, (3) Serving Others, (4) Knowing God.
- 2. The early church grew because of the service of their good news and because of the good news of their service.
- 3. In general, most people gravitate to one or two of the four, and struggle with or disregard the others.
- 4. There four categories are all connected with each other, and it takes all four for us to be transformed into being people of love.

- Which of the characteristics of a disciple do you sense God wanting to grow you in right now?
- Which of these do you feel hesitant about or resistant to?
- Has God put anyone in your life that he may lead you to disciple?
