Week 2: Who is Jesus? | Teacher: Libin Abraham Sermon Questions for 8.24.2025

Opener

Do you enjoy conversations filled with opinions or with facts more?

Read

Colossians 1:15-23; Hebrews 1:3; John 1:18;

Main Points

- 1. Paul writes this hymn to share two specific truths about who Jesus is: (1) Jesus, Lord of Creation, and (2) Jesus, Lord of New Creation.
- 2. We can only experience Jesus to be sufficient for us once we believe that he is supreme above all.
- 3. Right now, we are risen spiritually with him, but one day we will be risen physically with Jesus and we will face-to-face enjoy the reality of Jesus being the head of the Church.
- 4. The same Jesus who created all things reconciles all things to himself by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.
- 5. Because of Jesus, we are no longer presented as sinners, or rebels to the Father, rather Jesus presents us to the Father as holy, faultless, and blameless before him.

Engage with God in a Group

- How does this passage impact your understanding of who Jesus is and why does it matter for us today?
- What are the places in your life where you feel there's a lack of peace?
- How might our relationships be impacted if we started with Jesus before and above it all while also being intimately involved in every part of our lives?
- When was the last time you were stuck with awe by the reality of who Jesus is and what he's done for you?

Bottom Line

This is the revelation of who Jesus is: Lord of Creation and Lord of New Creation because by his physical death and by his blood on the cross, we are reconciled to God.
