Opener

What do you think most people would say makes life meaningful?

Read

Colossians 1:24-29; Galatians 2:20; Romans 8:9-10; Colossians 3:3

Main Points

1. Paul would say that, what makes a life meaningful is the *Indwelt Life* - The word indwell means that something or someone is permanently present within you. The secret to Paul's life was not that Paul was full of himself, but that he was full of Christ.
2. The meaningful life is a *Transformed Life* - living in and with God's wisdom, seeing God, yourself, and the world through the lens of Christ.
3. The meaningful life is a *Missional Life* - no matter our profession, we all have the same mission: to make Jesus known.
4. The meaningful life is an *Empowered Life* - the good news for all of us is that, as we give our lives over to the mission of God, God pours out his power into us.
5. The meaningful life is a *Glory-bound Life* - the presence of Christ in your life is the real promise of glory for you.
6. Not only is Christ in us, we are in Christ.

- Which part of a meaningful life have you experienced most often?
- How might living from Christ-in-you impact how you engage with those around you and the conversations you have with loved ones?
