Opener

What is your favorite Christmas song?

Read

Luke 1:46-56

Main Points

1. There are songs about the season - Jingle Bells, Rocking Around the Christmas Tree, Frosty the Snowman - these have nothing to do with Jesus but they are festive and fun.
2. There are songs about the Savior - O Come O Come Emmanuel, O Holy Night, Away in a Manger - they have a way of lifting our eyes to Jesus, the true wonder of what Christmas is all about.
3. The first Christmas, many felt hopeless, confused, weary, and alone yet at the arrival of Jesus turned their sadness into songs. The first Christmas gave them something to sing about.
4. Songs of hope are sung through the dark nights of the soul.
5. God sees the humble, and he is mighty and he is holy.
 - a. If God were mighty but not holy - we could not trust him. If God were holy but not mighty - he could not save us.

- How would you describe where your soul is during this Christmas season?
- What does hope mean to you at this point in your life?
- What do you hope for during this Christmas season - for you, for your loved ones, for our world?
