

KAYAK CAMP PACKING LIST

Camp Supplies

- 3-man tent or bigger
- Sleeping cot - a sleep pad is not recommended.
- Bedding / Pillow – it gets colder than you think.
- Flashlight
- Lawnchair
- Drying clothes line
- Water bottle
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Life jacket - zip or buckle recommended
- Bible
- Journal / pen / highlighter

Toiletries

- Toothbrush
- Deodorant
- Shampoo
- Body Wash
- Sunscreen
- Hairbrush
- Skincare
- Bugspray
- Medication labeled in pill organizer
- Washcloth / Loofa
- 2 shower towels
- 2 river towels
- Caddy to carry shower items
- Plastic bags to bring wet/dirty items home
- Feminine hygiene products – even if you think you won't need them

Clothes

- 10 shirts
- 10 shorts
- Undergarments
- 2 swimsuits
- Socks
- Pajamas
- Rain Jacket
- Sweatshirt / Hoodie
- Long sleeve, quick dry shirt for river
- River shoes - open toe is not recommended.
- Shoes - shower, camp, hiking

Notes:

- Pack everything in large sterilite containers. This keeps things from getting dirty, wet, or animals getting in.
- It gets much colder than you think! Bring extra bedding and a good sweatshirt/hoodie.
- Label EVERYTHING with your name!
- Students may bring their cell phones (no other electronics). They will turn in their phones during check-in on Sunday. Each evening, students will be given 30 minutes of phone time. They will check their phone out with their counselor, and stay in the main pavilion area to use their phone to make calls, check in, take photos, etc. Students will check their phones back in with their counselors after, and they will be locked away.
- Make sure your tent has its RAIN FLAP with it. Practice putting up your tent ahead of time, and make sure you have all the cords, tent spikes, etc, that you will need.
- Vapes, cigarettes, weapons, alcohol, fireworks, etc, are not allowed to be brought. Students will be given the opportunity to turn those things in to a camp director or counselor by the end of Sunday evening, and have a clean slate for the rest of the week. Any student found with these items after Sunday will be sent home. Camp directors reserve the right to check a student's belongings.
