In our Art workshops, Mr. Philip returned to share a beautiful two day lesson on self-image and drawing self-portraits and portraits of their peers. Through this project, our students practiced seeing themselves with joy and pride—capturing not just their likenesses, but their growing sense of individuality.



Our "Dream School Family" continues to grow, and we have so many people to thank for making this programming possible. This fall, our space was filled with the consistent care and enthusiasm of our incredible high school volunteers from The Academy of Our Lady of Peace, who show up week after week for our kids. They arrive ready to share, ready to learn and ready to build relationships with our Dream School students.



We've also been lucky to host some brilliant guest instructors. Our partners from USD's Neuroscience department led an engaging two-part workshop, teaching the kids how the brain works and then researching the Dream School students' big questions to share upon returning for part two. Ms. Claudia has been a constant source of wonder in her science labs, bringing science to life with hands-on experiments. Coach John continues to keep everyone moving and pushing their limits in fitness class. The sounds of pianos and guitars fill our space three days a week thanks to Mr. Brian (piano) and Lilith (guitar). Our students had a wonderful opportunity to showcase their talents with both a guitar recital in Point Loma, and a piano recital at our Holiday Party. The students continue to learn how to manage their emotions and explore coping strategies in the focused quiet of our Wellness Workshops with our Ms. Maxine and her MFT trainees, every corner of Dream School has been alive with energy.





Speaking of energy, we have to give another huge "Thank You" to our friends in the San Diego running community! In November, our students had a blast cheering on the runners from Milestone Running during their weekly Hump Day Run Club. That partnership and the generosity of the runners helped bring in over \$1,200 in donations for Dream School in one evening. 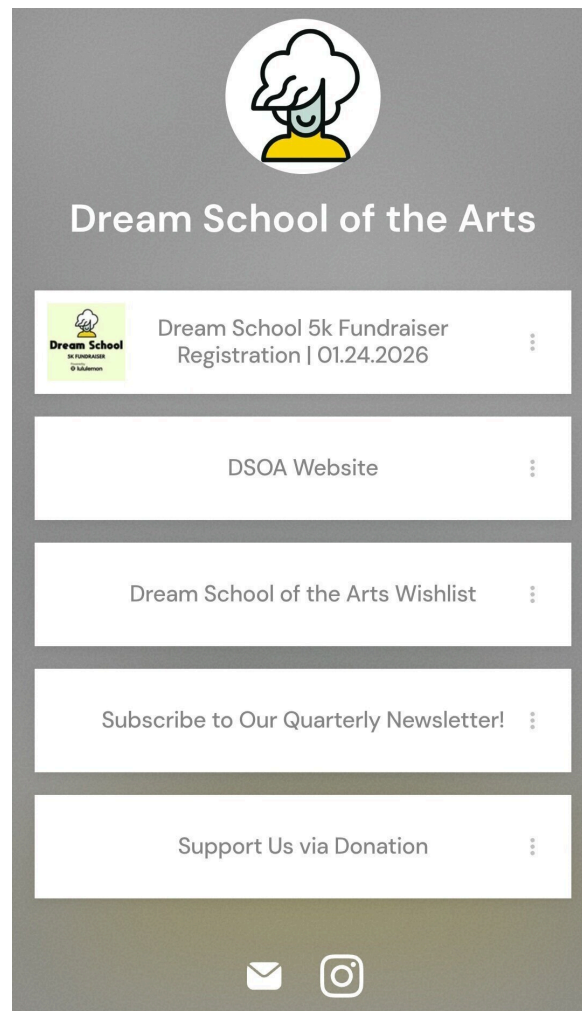
