March 23rd - 2 Peter 1:1-15

To Start:

- Make sure everyone has become acquainted with each other.
- <u>Ice Breaker</u>: What was a home or work project that you have been a part of that required a lot of effort?



- 2 Peter 1:3-4 says God has given us everything we need for life and godliness. What are some ways you've seen God provide what you need in your spiritual walk? Try to give a specific example.
- How do you see both "grace" (God's provision) and "grit" (our effort) playing a role in your spiritual growth?



 Peter emphasizes brotherly affection and love as part of spiritual maturity. How can you better demonstrate these in your relationships with other believers?

"Life in Community"

 What role does accountability play in developing the virtues Peter describes? Do you have accountability in your life?



- 2 Peter 1:9 warns that those who lack these virtues become nearsighted and forget their salvation. How can remembering our own forgiveness motivate us to share the gospel with others?
- How do the virtues in this passage make us more effective witnesses for Christ? Can you share an example of how a specific virtue has opened a door for you to point someone towards Jesus?
