## To Start:

- Where do you see truth under attack in the world around you today?
   How should we respond biblically and compassionately?
- John says that many antichrists have come (1 John 2:18). What modern examples of false teaching or deception concern you most, and why?
- What opportunities has God given you recently to speak truth in love to someone who doesn't know lesus?
