Evangelism: God Has Gone Before Us
January 18th - Acts 10:1-33

To Start:

- **Ice Breaker:** Think about a significant conversation or relationship in your life. Looking back, can you see ways God was already at work before you ever realized it?

UP

"Life on Life"

- Peter receives clear direction from God but not the full picture. Why do you think God often calls His people to obedience before giving complete clarity?
 - Jesus says that no one comes to Him unless the Father draws them (John 6:44). How does this truth shape the way we pray for lost people?

IN

"Life in Community"

- Legalism had created barriers that God never intended. What kinds of man-made rules or assumptions can still divide believers today?
 - How can we encourage one another to listen for God's leading and take faithful steps of obedience, even when those steps feel uncomfortable?

OUT

"Life on Mission"

- Cornelius was already being prepared by God before Peter arrived. How does this change the way you think about evangelism and sharing your faith?
- The sermon emphasized that there is no true "cold-call" evangelism. How does that truth help reduce fear or pressure when talking with unbelievers?
