Evangelism Part 2: Sola Deo Gloria
January 25th - Acts 10:34-48

To Start:

"Life on Life"

- How does the truth of salvation by grace alone protect us from pride or despair?
 - Which of the "solas" (grace alone, faith alone, Christ alone, Scripture alone, God's glory alone) do you find most encouraging and why?

"Life in Community"

- Peter declares that God shows no partiality. How should this shape the way we view people who are different from us culturally, socially, or spiritually?
 - What are some subtle ways believers today might be tempted to add something to Christ when it comes to salvation?

OUT

"Life on Mission"

- Peter clearly proclaimed Christ alone without hesitation. What makes that difficult in today's cultural climate?
- Who is someone in your life who may believe in God but has not yet trusted in Christ alone for salvation?
- How does knowing that faith comes by hearing motivate us to speak the gospel clearly and confidently? (Romans 10:17)
