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When Mission Meets Resistance

June 28th - Acts 16:16-25a

To Start:

- Ice Breaker: Share about a time when you faced unexpected opposition while trying to do something good. How did you respond?

UP

"Life on Life"

- What does this passage teach us about spiritual warfare and the reality of spiritual opposition?
- Why do you think Paul and Silas were able to pray and sing after being beaten and imprisoned?

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IN

"Life in Community"

- The sermon emphasized that people are not our enemy; Satan is. How might remembering this change the way we respond to difficult people?
- Why is it important for Christians to speak truth with both conviction and love?
- Is there anyone in our group currently walking through a difficult season where they need encouragement, prayer, or practical support?

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OUT

"Life on Mission"

- The sermon mentioned that the gospel threatens idols such as autonomy, money, power, sexuality, and reputation. Which of these do you see most often in your sphere of influence?
- How can we communicate biblical truth without becoming argumentative or harsh?
