⁸ “The waters of this stream will make the salty waters of the Dead Sea fresh and pure. ⁹ There will be swarms of living things wherever the water of this river flows. Fish will abound in the Dead Sea, for its waters will become fresh. Life will flourish wherever this water flows. ¹⁰

The Gift of Faith

1 Corinthians 12:8-9. ⁸ For to one is given through the Spirit...⁹ faith.” (ESV)

Definition: The Gift of Faith is an extra-ordinary confidence in God.

Example: George Müller

The gift of great faith is restorative because it can often restore the faith of others. When those with great faith publicly and confidently trust God to come through it inspires others who may be struggling to believe to have a greater faith.

The Gift of Mercy

Romans 12:4-8. ⁸...*the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness. (ESV)*

Definition: The Gift of Mercy is a supernatural default a mindset and lifestyle of compassionate words and deeds.

Example: Mother Teresa

Those with the gift of mercy see the brokenness of the world and are compelled to act and speak to bring restoration through acts of compassion big and small.

The Gift of Healing

1 Corinthians 12:9. *⁹The same Spirit gives great faith to another, and to someone else the one Spirit gives the gift of healing.*” (NLT)

Definition: The Gift of Healing brings restoration to our bodies, reversing the effect of sin; taking away sickness, relieving pain, mending brokenness.

Example: Amanda Sant

Those with the gift of healing will find that God has chosen them for his own reasons to be his administrators of his divine healing for a given season, this season could be 10 seconds, or it could be 10 years. Those with this gift see God answer their prayers for healing when they step out in faith and ask.
